UFLPA Operational Guidance for Importers



CBP has released importer guidance to assist the trade community in preparing for the implementation of the UFLPA rebuttable presumption. Please be aware that this is CBP's importer guidance, which provides transparency to CBP's operational approach, and not the Forced Labor Enforcement Task Force's Strategy, which will provide additional importer guidance, required by the UFLPA.

Production Classification





Valuation Review



Declaring the correct value of goods is critical to the customs entry process. By law (19 U.S.C. §1484), the importer is responsible for using reasonable care to enter, classify and value imported merchandise, and for providing information necessary for Customs to properly assess duties, collect trade statistics and determine whether all other applicable legal requirements have been met.
